- Master of Arts in Theology, Major in Consecrated Life (civil degree: 93 units)
- Licentiate in Theology, with Specialization in Consecrated Life (ecclesiastical degree: 120 ECTS)
- Master of Arts in Theology, Major in Spirituality (civil degree: 90 units)

ICLA also offers a Triennial Program (3-year) for the attainment of the following doctoral degrees:

- Doctor in Theology, with Specialization in Consecrated Life (ecclesiastical degree)
- Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Theology, Major in Consecrated Life (civil degree)

I. PLAN OF STUDY

A. Basic Courses (18 units)

Most of the incoming students of ICLA usually have no background in theology because they have graduated from various secular faculties such as psychology, education, sociology, and engineering. For this reason, ICLA offers introductory courses in Theology to help them succeed in their masteral studies. These courses, each with 3 units, include the following:

1. Exploring the Bible
2. Introduction to Theology: Revelation and Faith
3. Christology
4. Pneumatology
5. Ecclesiology
6. Moral Theology

These 6 basic courses are given as an Intensive Summer Program (Summer Semester), with a duration of 2 weeks for each course.

The successful completion of these basic courses will enable the student to go through the actual Biennial Program, consisting of the following 5 segments, namely *major courses, cognate courses, elective courses, seminars, and thesis writing.*

II. DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN THEOLOGY

The **PhD in Theology** is a degree conferred in recognition of the candidate's command of a broad field of scholastic and scholarly research knowledge and of his ability to start out, organize, and work on original research that is based on his major field of interest and, most importantly, would contribute to the field of theology. The Ph.D. in Theology has one area of specialization, namely **PhD in Theology, Major in Consecrated Life**.

Requirements for the Degree:

1. Completion of the Curriculum (Plan of Study) with a total of sixty (60) units:
 - a) Basic Courses (6)
 - b) Core Philosophy Courses (9)
 - c) Major Courses (27)
 - d) Foreign Language (6)
 - e) Doctoral Dissertation (12)
2. As a rule, before presenting a Dissertation Proposal, one must successfully pass the Comprehensive Examinations.
3. After the dissertation proposal is approved, proceed to enroll in dissertation writing.
4. A doctoral dissertation that will really contribute to the progress and development of theology, i.e., a dissertation that contains new theological issues or at least presents theological issues in a new way. This central requirement includes the following:
 - a) Presentation and public defense of the dissertation proposal, approved by the Adviser and the Dean, before a panel of five (5) members;
 - b) Public/oral defense of the dissertation;
 - c) Approval of the dissertation, at least in its principal part, as decided by the panel.
5. Successful *Lectio Coram* (a teaching demonstration before the panel of five (5) examiners), done twenty-four (24) hours after the defense of the dissertation.
6. The final grade for the Doctoral degree is composed of:
 - a) General Weighted Average (20%),
 - b) Written Evaluation of the Dissertation (40%),
 - c) Oral Defense of the Dissertation (30%), and
 - d) *Lectio Coram* (10%).
